Rules for the Queen of Hearts Raffle

1. Utilize the Queen of Hearts manufacturer’s raffle board. The board has been developed specifically for this Raffle Game. The board has 54 sealed numbered cards. Under the sealed cards and randomly placed is a deck of poker cards with 2 Jokers. **A TUMBLER or similar device shall be used for mixing raffle tickets. Tickets shall be mixed in Public View.**

Playing the Queen of Hearts Raffle Game

- 1 Tickets will be sold for 1.00 each.
- 2 Drawing date will be each **“Designate a Day, Time & Location” Example:**
Friday, starting August 21st 2009 and ending Friday September 10th, 2010 (excluding December 25th 2009 and January 1st 2010) (54 weeks)
- 3 The purchaser holding the winning ticket will pick a card from the board.
- 4 To win the pot, you must pick the Queen of Hearts from the Raffle board.
- 5 If the Queen of Hearts is not drawn, the pot rolls over to the next week.
- 6 The pot will continue to build until the Queen of Hearts is drawn; this could take up to 54 weeks.
- 7 If you are not going to be present at the drawing, you must declare a numbered card from the board and write the number on your Raffle ticket stub and an **“Organization’s Member”** will open your numbered card selected. Winners will receive the same percentage of jackpot regardless of whether they are present.
- 8 If the winning ticket holder picks the Queen of Hearts, they will receive 70% of the pot. The **“Organization’s Title”** will get the other 30%.
- 9 **“Organization’s Title”** will withhold all taxes from winnings where applicable. You will be required to provide proper identification and information for taxes. All tickets and monies will be accounted for by **“Organization’s Title”** in accordance with all Department of Charitable Gaming requirements.
- 10 If it appears that the Charitable Gaming License may expire prior to the Raffle game being played out, then tickets will be sold and drawn the last night before license expiration, until some one draws the Queen of Hearts and wins the current pot.
- 11 If your ticket is drawn and you draw a pay card, you will receive the pay card prize and the prize for that stage ticket drawing. Example: 25.00 for getting your ticket drawn + 50.00 for the Joker = 75.00 (stage 1) **SEE PAGE #2**
- 12 Ticket sales start on **“Designate a Date, Time & Location”**.
- 13 Drawings will be held **“Designate a Date, Time & Location”**. **After the Raffle game has been fully paid out (Queen of Hearts was picked) then the Queen of Hearts Raffle Game board shall be retained by the organization for a minimum of 45 days.**

Prize Payouts Based on the Amount in the Jackpot
