To All Charitable Gaming Licensees:

The Department of Charitable Gaming has discovered from recent inspections that many licensed charitable gaming organizations are not taking the appropriate steps to ensure that children under age 18 are not playing electronic pulltab devices. Kentucky regulations require organizations that conduct charitable gaming with electronic pulltab devices to take the following steps to ensure all players are of legal age:

*“Before purchasing or being provided with an electronic pulltab device, a player shall present proof that the player is at least eighteen (18) years of age. Proof shall be in the form of a picture identification card that includes the player’s date of birth. If an organization uses a self-service point of sale kiosk, identification shall be presented and verified at the door.” 820 KAR 1:032, Sec. 33(7).*

Please promptly take the appropriate steps to ensure that your organization is in compliance with this regulation. Failure to do so could result in the Department issuing a Notice of Violation and seeking an administrative penalty against your organization.
