



What License Do I Need?

Type	Description	Fee
Full Gaming License	Gross receipts will exceed \$25,000 in a license year. Organization can conduct Bingo, Pull Tabs, Raffles and Non-Cash Prize Wheels, and casino type gaming. Organization must notify our office at least 10 days in advance of any changes.	\$100-\$300
Exemption Acknowledgement	Gross receipts for all gaming has to be less than \$25,000 per calendar year. Organization can conduct Bingo, Raffles, Non-Cash Prize Wheels and Charity Fundraising Events. No pull tab sales or casino type gaming. Organization must notify our office at least 10 days in advance of location change.	NONE
Temporary License	Apply for this license when your organization wants to change their gaming location for one particular event to hold Bingo, Raffles, NCPW's not currently listed on your full gaming license. The organization must request this change at least 10 days in advance of any change.	\$25
CFE License	Organization must complete Form CG-Schedule-A. This activity is limited to 72 hours. A CFE license is issued for an event that brings in the general public for something other than gaming, such as a fair, festival, carnival or bazaar. This would also be issued if you wanted to sell pull tabs at a location other than what is listed on your full gaming license. Example games: Bingo, Horse Race Bingo, Prerecorded Horse Racing, Pulltabs, Raffles, NCPW (<100), duck race or golf ball drop, etc. You can only apply for a maximum of 4 of these a license year, two of which can be SLCFE events.	\$25
SLCFE License	Organization must complete Form CG-Schedule-A. This activity is limited to 6 hours. A SLCFE license is issued for an event that is predominately casino type games. Examples: Blackjack, Poker, Dice games, Roulette, Keno, Baccarat, Quarter Push, Money Wheels (Cash Prizes), Texas Hold'em, Horse Race by roll of dice and any other types of casino gaming. You can apply for a maximum of 2 of these per license year.	\$25
Pull Tabs	Requires a Form CG-Schedule-A or full gaming license. If your organization has an area in which they wish to sell pull tabs, they may request this additional license when obtaining a full license.	FEE: No charge at time of full license issuance. \$25 thereafter.
Raffles	Required to be listed on the full gaming license or must request a temporary license. The license will show the day, time and location of the drawing only.	\$25

****All gaming activity must have day/time/location printed on the license. License must be displayed during gaming activities!****
